

Portugal Golden Income Fund

Fund Report | July 31st, 2025

Manager Comment and Outlook

The Portugal Golden Income Fund delivered a robust +1.92% return to investors in July, with performance predominantly driven by its allocation to digital assets via the Fund's investment in the 3CC Global Crypto Fund. This exposure contributed 92 basis points, accounting for nearly half of the Fund's total monthly gain.

A powerful confluence of supportive macroeconomic conditions and significant crypto-native catalysts underpinned this performance. With major central banks maintaining a cautious stance on interest rates, global equity markets advanced to record highs. The S&P 500 registered multiple alltime closing levels, while the Nasdaq Composite surpassed the 21,000 mark for the first time. This favorable environment was mirrored in the cryptocurrency market, where historic regulatory breakthroughs in the U.S., including the passage of the GENIUS and CLARITY Acts, provided longawaited oversight for digital assets. In this "risk-on" climate, Bitcoin broke decisively through the key \$110,000 resistance, rallying to a new all-time high of \$123,000 and delivering a 12.64% return over the month in euros. Notably, Ethereum, the second-largest digital asset by market capitalization, surged 57.83% in euro terms, reinforcing the market's shift toward a broader-based rally beyond Bitcoin. Additionally, the EU and the US sealed a deal introducing 15% tariffs on European goods less than initially threatened, but more than what the EU had pushed for, also adding to the positive environment. As a result, trade uncertainty should now have less impact on the markets.

Within the Fund's fixed-income allocation, the National Energy Grid Operator REN (Redes Energéticas Nacionais) was the largest single contributor in July, adding 16 basis points to overall performance. The second-largest contributor was the insurance company Fidelidade (FIDELI 7 3/4 PERP), which added 13 basis points. The iBoxx € Corporates benchmark gained 0.52% during the month, broadly in line with the Portuguese corporate bond universe. Within the index, the bestperforming sectors were Real Estate, Energy, and Telecommunications, while Basic Materials, Health Care, and Consumer Goods posted the lowest gains.

REN's performance was underpinned by a 35.2% year-on-year increase in net profit to €65.7 million for the first half of 2025, driven primarily by favourable tax effects - including a €19 million reduction in tax liabilities - and a €280 million (-11.9%) reduction in net debt, which lowered the average cost of debt to 2.66%. While EBITDA slipped marginally by 0.5% to €256.6 million, reflecting higher domestic operating expenses and lower remuneration of regulated assets, capital expenditure continued to expand, reaching €150 million over the period. Operationally, electricity consumption in Portugal reached a record high of 26,229 GWh in the first half of 2025, with renewable sources accounting for 77% of total demand. In strategic terms, REN has also reinforced its leadership in Portugal's energy transition. Recently, the company commissioned its largest renewable energy transmission project in two decades. Spanning 150 kilometers of new transmission lines, over 400 pylons, and substantial substation upgrades, this infrastructure will play a pivotal role in integrating new renewable energy generation capacity - particularly solar - into the national grid. The project directly supports the objectives of Portugal's National Energy and Climate Plan (PNEC) 2030 and strengthens the security and resilience of the National Electricity System. This strategic positioning in a growth sector further enhances REN's long-term fundamentals, underpinning the quality of its fixed-income profile within the Fund's portfolio.

The Fund's 3.35% allocation to gold, held through the AMUNDI PHYSICAL GOLD ETC, contributed 11 basis points to July's performance, with the bulk of this gain driven by favourable currency movements. In U.S. dollar terms, gold rose a modest 0.34% over the month; however, when measured in euros, the metal advanced 2.73%, benefiting from the dollar's relative strength against the euro in July, as this ETC tracks the spot price of gold in US dollars. From a strategic perspective, the asset continues to play a pivotal role in the portfolio, offering diversification benefits and acting as a long-term hedge against currency debasement and geopolitical uncertainty.

The Investment Committee's decision to raise the Fund's equity exposure to nearly 20% of the portfolio has continued to yield positive results, as global equity markets posted strong gains in July. Our allocation to the AMUNDI S&P 500 II UCITS ETF was the single largest contributor, adding 43 basis points to performance. International diversification also played a meaningful role, with our position in the MSCI World ex-USA ETF contributing 13 basis points, supported by notable advances in both European and Japanese markets.

The S&P 500 extended its rally in July, rising 2.17% and bringing its year-to-date return to 7.78% in U.S. dollar terms. The index recorded 10 new all-time highs during the month, including a rare "perfect week" of five consecutive record closes. However, for European investors, the situation is markedly different. When measured in euros, the S&P 500 registered a negative year-to-date return of -4%. This divergence results from the 12% depreciation of the U.S. dollar against the euro since January, underlining the significant influence that currency fluctuations exert on cross-border investment performance.

The second-quarter earnings season provided a major catalyst for the positive results. With over 90% of companies having reported, the S&P 500 has delivered blended year-over-year earnings growth of 11.8% - more than double the 5% anticipated at the end of June - while revenues rose 6.3%, the fastest pace since Q3 2022. Earnings have exceeded consensus estimates by 8.4% on average, with 81% of companies beating EPS forecasts and an equal 81% surpassing revenue expectations, both well above long-term averages. Strength has been broad-based across sectors, with market leadership gradually expanding beyond mega-cap technology names.

Looking ahead, corporate guidance has been cautiously optimistic. For the third quarter, the number of companies issuing positive earnings guidance slightly exceeds those issuing negative guidance. Analysts currently project earnings growth of 5% to 7% for Q3 2025, underscoring the resilience of the U.S. corporate sector and providing a supportive backdrop for risk assets, with strong earningsper-share (EPS) growth largely offsetting valuation pressures.

Overview

Fund Objective

The primary objective is to provide participants with exposure to various asset classes, with a regional focus on issuers based in Portugal. The Fund will allocate a minimum of 65% of their assets under management to issuers based in Portugal.

Investment Strategy

To achieve its investment objectives, the Fund primarily invests in credit instruments, specifically bonds, with fixed or variable rates. and an appropriate credit rating for investment (Investment Grade) or equivalent. The fund may also invest in equities, with a minimum allocation of 10% and a maximum of 30% of its assets. Invest in alternative assets, including Digital Assets, through indirect investment in Funds and/or Exchange-Traded Funds, with a minimum allocation of 0% and a maximum of 20% of its assets

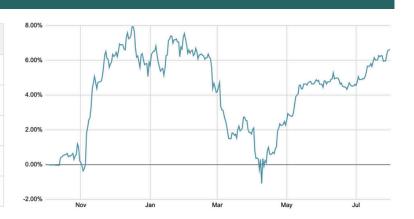


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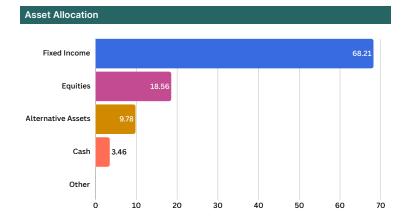

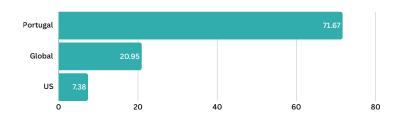
